RULES

1. **All electrical Gear to be tested and tagged.**
2. All cattle must be entered in the bona fide owner name and be registered or eligible for registration in recognized herd book.
3. Age of all beef cattle is determined from 1st June in each year and deemed to be one year older on that date.

4. Animals entered in group classes must be entered in at least one other class for what they are eligible.
5. Exhibitors are to state breed of entries on entry form.
6. No cow will be allowed in the judging ring which, in the opinion of the steward, is unduly overstocked with milk.
7. The following practices are **banned** from the Dairy Section at All A & P Shows.

- a) The administration of any drug to enhance the appearance of an animal.
- b) The gluing, sealing or taping of teats or the use of artificial practices to affect the teat angle or teat placement.
- c) the infusion of any substance to the mammary system to alter the outward appearance of the udder or milk veins.
- d) The Gore A & P Assn reserve the right to conduct random milk or blood testing.

These practices in any form, will be considered an act of malpractice at A & P shows with disqualification likely to result

8. All cattle must be from a TB free or TB accredited and brucellosis free herd of C2 Herd Status or greater. A copy of latest herd test certificate must accompany the entry form.

9. Cattle, three months of age and over farmed or grazed within a declared TB Movement Controlled Area must be negative to a TB test within 60 days prior to the Show.

10. All cattle three months of age and over must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated Declaration Card showing an Accredited TB Free Status in accordance with present legislation.

11. It is a requirement that ALL cattle will be correctly identified using an official NAIT tags as implemented on 1st July 2012 in accordance with present legislation. It is the responsibility of the livestock exhibitors to record all animal movements with NAIT 48 hours prior to leaving the farm/property for the show.
